## MACCLESFIELD COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION Inc. CODE OF CONDUCT FOR VOLUNTEERS WORKING WITH CHILDREN.

All volunteers of the Macclesfield Community Association Inc. (MCA) who participate in activities /events organised by the MCA for children and young people are responsible for promoting their safety and well being by:

- Adhering to the MCA's Child Safety Policy and taking responsible steps to ensure the safety and protection of the children and young people with whom they interact.
- 2. Treating everyone with respect and honesty including other volunteers, bystanders and parent/caregivers as well as the children and young people involved.
- 3. Listening and responding appropriately to the views and concerns of children and young people.
- 4. Being a positive role model in all your conduct.
- 5. Setting clear boundaries about appropriate behaviour between yourself and the children and young people involved.
- 6. Ensuring another adult is always present or insight when conducting one to one activities.
- 7. Responding fairly to, and reporting to the organising person, any serious complaints made by those involved or to their parents/carers.
- 8. Reporting suspected child abuse and neglect to the child abuse Report line (13 14 78) as soon as practicable.

## **Volunteers must not:**

- Engage in rough physical games with the children and young people involved.
- Develop any 'special' relationships with the children or young people involved that could be seen as favouritism.
- Do things of a personal nature that a child or young person can do for themselves, such as toileting or changing clothes.
- Discriminated against any child or young person because of age, gender, cultural background, religion, disability or sexuality.
